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2D Shapes Learning Intention

Questions to Extend and Deepen Understanding

While the children are completing the challenge, you may wish to ask them the following questions:

- What can you tell me about this shape?
- How many sides does this shape have?
- Which cards can I put on this poster?
- Could this shape go on this poster?
- How are these shapes similar? How are they different?
- I think this shape should go on this poster. Am I correct? Why? Why not?

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Challenge Set-Up Instructions

1. Print the 2D Shape Sorting Posters and the 2D Shape Cards from the 2D Shape and Their Properties Sorting Activity.
2. Assemble the posters and cut out the cards.
3. Place the posters in an area for children to use and spread out the cards near the posters. For the 'Burning Up' challenge, you may wish to remove the circle cards.
4. Then working with the children, you may wish to use the suggested questions to extend and deepen their understanding of 2D shapes.
