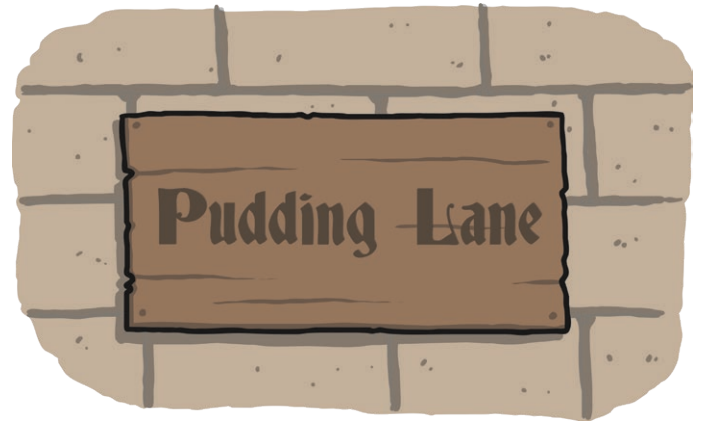


Great Fire of London Board Game

You will need:

- A counter for each person
- A dice
- Great Fire of London Task Cards



Before you play:

- A game for 2 or more people.
- You are going to take on the role of a man named Samuel Pepys.
- Samuel Pepys wrote a diary and newspaper articles. A lot of what we know about the Great Fire of London is because of Samuel Pepys.

How to play:

- Decide who will go first. It could be the youngest player, or you could all roll the dice and the person with the highest score goes first.
- Roll the dice and move your counter along the board that number of squares.
- Look at the square you landed on. Some squares have events about the Great Fire of London on. Landing on these squares might move you closer to the finish, or nearer to the start again.
- Other squares have the words 'Great Fire of London Task Card' on them. If you land on one of these squares, choose a Great Fire of London Task Card. If you complete the task, you get to move on two spaces. However, if you do not complete it, you stay on that space until your next turn.
- The first person to land on the final square wins.
